BYLAW NO. 07/18

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TISDALE TO PROVIDE
FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF MILL RATE FACTORS.**

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as the “Mill Rate Factor Bylaw”.
- 2. The purpose of this bylaw is to set mill rate factors applicable to the classes of land and improvements for the purpose of taxation.
- 3. a) The following mill rate factors shall be applied to the following classes of assessment:

<u>Class</u>	<u>Mill Rate Factor</u>
Agricultural	1.000
Residential	0.715
Commercial	2.680

- b) The mill rate factors are applicable to the municipal mill rate.
- 4. Bylaw No. 05/17 is hereby repealed.
