

TOWN OF TISDALE
BYLAW NO. 2/91


A BYLAW TO PROTECT CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PROPERTY

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Manager of Parks and Recreation (The Manager) and such employees or other persons as he may delegate are hereby authorized to plant, transplant, place and otherwise install trees, hedges and shrubs on such municipal property and in such manner as he may decide.
2. No person shall on any boulevard or other municipal property without the permission of the Manager first had and obtained:
 - i) plant, transplant, place or otherwise install any tree, sapling, shrub or any vegetation whatsoever
 - ii) place any boulders, rocks, fence or other materials whatsoever
 - iii) otherwise alter or deface;
3. No person shall remove, root up, cut, break or in any way injure or damage any tree, hedge, shrub, plant, flowers, turf or any building, structure, fence, or other property of the Town of Tisdale located on any boulevard or other municipal property.
4. No person shall remove, injure, deface or destroy any notice, rule or regulation for the governing of any park or boulevard which is posted or affixed with the authority of Council.
5. No person shall display any bill, placard, or advertising matter whatsoever within any park or upon any boulevard without the permission of the Manager.
6. The Manager and his delegates are hereby authorized and required to enforce the provisions of this Bylaw.

7. The Manager or any police officer, constable or other person appointed by him may notify any person in contravention of the provisions of this Bylaw to remedy such contravention, and, in the case of such person's failure to do so immediately, the Manager or his delegate may, to the extent possible, remedy such contravention and the costs thereof shall be borne by and are collectable from such person.
8. Any permission or authorization to be given by the Manager hereunder shall only be effective if given in writing, and an application for such Permit shall be made in such form and manner as the Manager may require.
9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense punishable on summary conviction and is subject to the penalties contained in General Penalty Bylaw No. 385 of the Town of Tisdale.
