BYLAW NO. 3/06

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TISDALE TO DISPENSE WITH THE MAILING OF ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting enacts as follows:

The Assessor of the Town of Tisdale is hereby authorized by Section 214 of the Municipalities Act to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices where the assessed value with respect to any land or improvement:

1. Has not changed from the previous year's assessed value; or
2. The increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
 - a) \$1,000 from the previous year's assessed value; and
 - b) 1% of the previous year's assessed value
3. This bylaw is effective with respect to the current year and all subsequent years, other than an assessment revaluation year.
4. Bylaw Number 256 is hereby repealed
