BYLAW NO. 09/16

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Town of Tisdale in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) “Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b) “Council” shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - c) “Municipality” shall mean the Town of Tisdale.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly to the persons who receive the service in accordance with Schedule “A” which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services. If the person is a non-resident or does not own property Council may authorize the Administrator to send the unpaid invoice to a collections company for the purposes of collection.
4. This Bylaw shall take effect upon final reading of Council.

SCHEDULE “A”

1. Non-Vehicular Fires Within the limits of the Town of Tisdale
  - No Charge
2. Non-Vehicular Fires Outside the Town of Tisdale  
but within the Tisdale & District Fire Protection Area Boundaries
  - Basic Charge of \$500 per call including the first hour
  - Plus \$300 per hour thereafter
  - In addition a rate of \$21 per hour for each fireman
  - Plus mileage of \$2.00 per unit per km to and from the fire
3. All Vehicular Fires (Both Within and Outside of the Town of Tisdale)
  - \$873 Hourly Rate for Productive Call
  - \$524 Hourly Rate for Non-Productive Call
4. All Fires Outside the Boundaries of the Tisdale & District Fire Protection Area
  - A Basic Charge of \$1,000 per call including the first hour
  - Plus \$600 per hour thereafter
  - In addition a rate of \$42 per hour for each fireman
  - Plus mileage of \$4.00 per unit per km charge to and from the fire
