

**TOWN OF TISDALE
BYLAW NO. 08/22
COMMERCIAL SNOW REMOVAL BYLAW**

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PURPOSE

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to enforce the removal of snow and ice from public sidewalks to ensure public safety and accessibility.

AUTHORITY

2. The authority for this Bylaw is section 8, of *The Municipalities Act*.

DEFINITIONS

3. a) CAO – shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Tisdale.
b) Costs – shall mean the Administrative costs in adding the costs to taxes as per Town of Tisdale Bylaw No. 04/14.
c) Curb – shall mean the actual curb to a street and, if there be no curb in existence, shall mean the dividing line between that part of a public highway intended for use by vehicles and that part of a public highway intended for use by pedestrians.
d) Expenses – shall mean any fees, costs or wage expenses incurred by the Town in enforcing compliance with this Bylaw whether it be using internal labour or contracted services.

SNOW REMOVAL

4. Every owner of land adjoining a sidewalk in the areas listed in the attached Schedule “A” shall clear the sidewalk of all snow and ice within forty-eight (48) hours of the time when the snow or ice was formed or deposited thereon.
5. The Town of Tisdale may take whatever actions or measures are necessary to remedy a contravention of this Bylaw and in the case of removing snow or ice, the Town of Tisdale may, pursuant to section 364 of *The Municipalities Act*, complete the work and add to the tax roll of the adjoining property the unpaid Expenses and Costs incurred by the Town of Tisdale for removing the snow and ice.
6. No person shall remove snow or ice from any public sidewalk by causing it to be placed upon any other portion of the sidewalk, public highway surfaces or parking lane with the exception that the snow and ice may be placed along the Curb face provided the snow and ice does not encroach onto the sidewalk nor extend more than 2.5 meters from the Curb face on to the public highway or parking lane.
7. For the purpose of enforcement of this Bylaw and sections 364, 366 and 369 of *The Municipalities Act*, the CAO, or any person designated by the CAO, are authorized to administer and enforce this Bylaw through any means authorized by *The Municipalities Act*.
8. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 1, 2022.
