2025 Assessment & Tax Information

2025 is a Reassessment year if you own a property. The Assessment Roll for the Town of Tisdale is open for inspection between March 13 to May 14, 2025. As a property owner you should have received a Notice of Assessment in the mail. You can contact SAMA (1-800-216-4427) to review your assessed value. If you wish to appeal your assessment you must complete the Notice of Appeal which is part of the assessment notice. The appeal and the required fees **must be received** no later than May 14, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.

Property owners can appeal if they believe there has been an error in

It is important to note that you cannot appeal on the grounds that the property assessment is too high. You must provide specific facts and evidence that support an error has been made in the points above. You can access other details property report for comparative properties by visiting the SAMAView web application free of charge at www.sk.ca/property-owner-services.

If you have not received your assessment notice by now please call the town office immediately.

2025 Tax Notices are scheduled to be mailed on or before April 30, 2025. Please remember that you are not able to appeal the tax notice. If you don't receive your notice in the first week of May please contact our office.

Receive at 15% DISCOUNT on Municipal Taxes (excluding Long Term Care Levy & Local Improvements) if payment is RECEIVED IN OFFICE BY MAY 31, 2025. A declining discount is offered until November 30, 2025. To pay your FULL tax amount via preauthorized payment please contact The Tow Office by March 10, 2025. Residents are welcome to pay by cash, cheque or debit, or you can pay through your online banking.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: Recycle Bins are NOT meant for garbage OR yard clean up. A list of items accepted in the recycle bins can be found on the Town Website, www.tisdale.ca or contact the Town Office for more information.

SPRING CLEAN UP: Our landfill has free disposal of trees, branches, grass, leaves, garden refuse and other compostable materials – make sure these items are free of garbage and debris.

Paying your Utility Bill or Taxes ONLINE?

HELPFUL TIPS for setting up your
Utility OR Tax Account **ONLINE**
through your financial
institution:

1. Search 'Tisdale' as a payee and be sure to select the **CORRECT** payment option, TAXES OR UTILITIES.
 2. Use the account number (not customer number) off of your **CURRENT** Utility Bill or Tax Notice.
 3. IF NEEDED, add additional zero's to the account or tax number if more digits required.

DUTCH ELM DISEASE: The Town of Tisdale wants you to be aware that Dutch Elm Disease is in our community and that it can be prevented with your help! Please contact the Town Office if you are suspicious about a dead or dying branch on your Elm Tree(s). Residents can pick up brochures at the Town Office for more information regarding Dutch Elm Disease. **PLEASE NOTE that the pruning ban is in effect from April 1st to August 31st for all American and Siberian Elm trees. It is ILLEGAL to transport, use or store elm firewood. Let's save our beautiful elm trees!**

DOG OWNERS: Kindly respect our environment and clean up after your dog.
It's a social and lawful responsibility to ALL dog owners.

It is **UNLAWFUL** to cut down trees that are on Town property. If you have a tree and are questioning if it's owned by you or the Town, please contact the Town Office before you start trimming!
