SNOW REMOVAL



Pushing or blowing snow from your driveway into the street creates twice as much for the grader to move, either ending up back in your driveway or your neighbors. Let's work together to assist our operators in snow removal this winter!!

Residents are reminded that one of the biggest hindrances we face in clearing streets is vehicles left parked for more than 48 hours. When the equipment has to go around parked cars the snow accumulated may end up in the driveway. After a heavy snowfall ridges are sometimes unavoidable and inevitable. If you are unable to remove this ridge residents are encouraged to have someone lined up to have them removed. Please do your part by keeping vehicles moved in a timely manner and if possible, keeping them off of the street after a heavy snowfall. Also, please remove your Garbage & Recycle bins from the street **ASAP** after the bins have been emptied. If you have a residence that does not have a front driveway and you require a spot to be left clear of a snow pile for your garbage & recycle bins, **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO MARK THE AREA WITH A STAKE AND AN ORANGE FLAG.** If the area is not marked, it will not be cleared.
