If you own property in the Town of Tisdale you will be receiving an Assessment Notice in the Spring of 2025! The Assessment Roll will be open to inspection for a period of 60 days.

If you wish to appeal your assessment you will be required to file the notice of appeal during the 60 day period. Please review the information provided with your assessment notice and feel free to contact our office with any questions you have.

DID YOU KNOW? That every person who leaves a waste or recycle container on a public right-of-way for more than 24 hours commits an offence under Bylaw 6-13 (section 73.h)

Any person who contravenes a provision of Section 73 is guilty of an offence and liable of summary conviction to a fine:

- a) For the first offence, of \$100;
 - b) For a second offence, of \$200; and
 - c) For a third or subsequent offence, of not less than \$200 and not more than \$10,000 in the case of individual or \$25,000 in case of a corporation
- Bylaw 6-13 Waste Bylaw

SNOW REMOVAL



Pushing or blowing snow from your driveway into the street creates twice as much for the grader to move, either ending up back in your driveway or your neighbors. Let's work together to assist our operators in snow removal this winter!!

Residents are reminded that one of the biggest hindrances we face in clearing streets is vehicles left parked for more than 48 hours. If you see a car which has not been moved in 48 hours, let our office know so we can take further action. When the equipment has to go around parked cars the snow accumulated may end up in the driveway. After a heavy snowfall ridges are sometimes unavoidable and inevitable. If you are unable to remove this ridge residents are encouraged to have someone lined up to have them removed. Please do your part by keeping vehicles moved in a timely manner and if possible, keeping them off of the street after a heavy snowfall. Also, please remove your Garbage & Recycle bins from the street **ASAP** after the bins have been emptied.

BINS MUST BE KEPT OFF THE STREET WHEN IT IS NOT YOUR GARBAGE OR RECYCLE DAY!!!

If you have a residence that does not have a front driveway and you require a spot to be left clear of a snow pile for your garbage & recycle bins, **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO MARK THE AREA WITH A STAKE AND AN ORANGE FLAG.** If the area is not marked, it will not be cleared.
