

## CANDIDATES AND NOMINATORS ELIGIBILITY

### Who can be nominated? (Candidates Eligibility)

A person is eligible to be nominated as a candidate in a municipal election and to hold office as a member of council if the person:

- (a) is **at least 18 years of age** on the day of the election;
- (b) is **not disqualified** pursuant to this or any other Act;
- (c) is a Canadian citizen at the time that he or she submits the nomination paper;
- (d) has **resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months** immediately preceding the date on which he or she submitted the nomination paper and **has resided in that municipality**, or on land now in that municipality, **for at least three consecutive months** immediately preceding the date on which he or she submitted the nomination paper.

### Who can nominate a candidate? (Nominators Eligibility)

A nominator must be **eligible to vote** in that municipality.

A person is eligible to vote in a municipality or school division who, on election day:

- (a) is a **Canadian citizen**;
- (b) is **at least 18 years of age**;
- (c) has **resided in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months** immediately preceding the day of the election and has **resided in the municipality, or on land now in the municipality, for at least three consecutive months** immediately preceding the day of the election; or (ii) is the **owner of assessable land in the municipality**, or land now situated in the municipality, for **at least three consecutive months** immediately preceding the day of the election.
