NOTICE UTILITY RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2024

As per Bylaw 07/23 water rates increase starting January 2024. Changes will show on your April 2024 Utility Bill.

- Water service fee (flat rate) \$31.00 per month, \$62.00 bi-monthly
- Water consumption rate - \$9.75 per 1000 imperial gallons – Residential & Commercial
- Sewer consumption rate - \$4.50 per 1000 imperial gallons – Residential & Commercial.
- **Water disconnects & reconnects due to non-payment - \$50.00 + gst for each**
- Water reconnect for seasonal - \$50.00 + gst
- Bulk Water Rates at the water treatment plant - \$19.00 per 1000 imperial gallons

SNOW REMOVAL



Pushing or blowing snow from your driveway into the street creates twice as much for the grader to move, either ending up back in your driveway or your neighbors. Let's work together to assist our operators in snow removal this winter!!

Residents are reminded that one of the biggest hindrances we face in clearing streets is vehicles left parked for more than 48 hours. If you see a car which has not been moved in 48 hours, let our office know so we can take further action. When the equipment has to go around parked cars the snow accumulated may end up in the driveway. After a heavy snowfall ridges are sometimes unavoidable and inevitable. If you are unable to remove this ridge residents are encouraged to have someone lined up to have them removed. Please do your part by keeping vehicles moved in a timely manner and if possible, keeping them off of the street after a heavy snowfall.

Also, please remove your Garbage & Recycle bins from the street **ASAP** after the bins have been emptied. If you have a residence that does not have a front driveway and you require a spot to be left clear of a snow pile for your garbage & recycle bins, **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO MARK THE AREA WITH A STAKE AND AN ORANGE FLAG.** If the area is not marked, it will not be cleared
